

Arundel Castle Cricket Foundation Cycle Ride 2nd July 2021 Route details

The route starts by going south through Arundel and then via the hamlet of Binsted and village of Walberton before passing under the A29 to head north through the hamlets of Eartham and Upwaltham. After about three miles on the A285, we head down Duncton Hill (there will be a water stop near the top), left through the grounds of Seaford College to Graffham and then continue north through Selham, Lodsworth, Lickfold and on to Lurgashall. A buffet lunch will be served at the Noah's Ark from 12.00pm until 2.00pm.

MB Cyclery of Haslemere have kindly agreed to join us at Lurgashall to sort out any minor issues with our bikes.

After lunch, we have a further 17 miles to get back to the start in Arundel. Leaving Lurgashall, going south through Upperton and Tillington, we then have a mile on the A272 before going through Petworth and then via Byworth, Sutton and Blgnor before crossing the A29 to pass by Bury. A steady climb up to Houghton and then up a little further on the B2139 to the entrance to the Arundel Castle Estate ...in time for tea and drinks by the Arundel Castle Cricket ground.

The parts of the ride to be extra careful are:

Morning

- ~ Cycling through Arundel and around the roundabout on the A27
- ~ Going north on the A285 and down Duncton Hill
- ~ Crossing the A272 south of Lodsworth

Afternoon

- ~ Cycling the short distance on the A272 and through Petworth.
- ~ Crossing the A29 to Bury
- ~ Short cycle on B2139 from Houghton to the entrance to the Arundel Castle Estate.

There will be plenty of signage but please also be extra vigilant yourselves.
